- Not limited: organization must have separate, distinct ideas with different PI's and no overlapping teams or resources
- Deadline: September 13, 2024
- Funding will come from a total pool of up to \$250,000 access to the global Johnson & Johnson Innovation – JLABS network, and mentorship from experts across Johnson & Johnson for one year.
- Submit tools, platforms, technologies, or methods to enhance diversity, equity, and inclusion in clinical studies with the goal of increasing patient representation for global clinical trials focused on immune-mediated diseases.
