- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: September 27, 2024
- A stipend of \$85,000
- The Center seeks top-quality writing from academics as well as from creative writers and independent scholars. Visual artists whose projects require extensive use of Library collections are also encouraged to apply.

- Must be an early-career writer of fiction who has not yet published a book and is not currently nor has ever been enrolled in an advanced degree program (such as an MA or MFA) in Creative Writing, English, or Literature, and has no plans to attend one in the 2025 calendar year.

- Applicant must have completed all requirements for the PhD except the dissertation before beginning fellowship tenure.

- Selecting 30 fellows, each fellow receives up to \$90,000 in financial support over 2 years.
- This foundation invests in the graduate education of 30 New Americans—immigrants and children of immigrants—who are poised to make significant contributions to US society, culture, or their academic field.

Medical Research

[Autism Science Foundation](#) - **Profound Autism Pilot Grant**

- Foundation location: New York
- Geographical giving scope: National



- Deadline: October 18, 2024
- Multiple pilot grants will be awarded up to \$35,000.
- Applicants for this award must be either enrolled in a pre-doctoral training program, or hold an M.D., Ph.D., EdD, or ScD and currently hold a position at a university or institution.
 - 1) pilot studies to identify or characterize the underlying biological mechanisms of profound autism (including model systems);
 - 2) examination of the preliminary efficacy of a behavioral or pharmacological treatment for core or co-morbid symptoms of profound autism or severe, intense and dangerous behaviors;
 - 3) projects which address challenges in recruitment, retention or data collection in individuals with profound autism.

- 3-5 years with \$135,000 direct costs a year. 8% allowable indirect costs
- This grant supports full-time faculty members in becoming independent investigators as clinician scientists.

 [American Cancer Society](#) – **Leukemia Exploration and Prevention Grant Program**

- Applicants may only apply for one of the two funding mechanisms: the LEAP-Research Scholar Grant or the LEAP-Team Award.
- Up to \$215,000 per year for up to 4 years, for the team award up to \$430,000 per year for up to 4 years.
- Applicants for this program must propose a research project in one of their 2 areas of focus.

- PCORI seeks to fund high-quality patient-centered comparative clinical effectiveness research projects that focus on interventions that improve patient-centered outcomes in U.S. children and youth. Target population is 0-24 years.

PCORI – **Advancing the Science of Engagement in Research**

- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: October 1, 2024
- Up to \$4.5 million.
- PCORI seeks to fund studies that build an evidence base on engagement in research. See website for more details.

Ovarian Cancer Research Alliance – **Rosalind Franklin Excellence in Ovarian Cancer Research Prize**

- Not limited
- Foundation location: New York
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: October 9, 2024
- A one-time payment of \$10,000 will be awarded. Given to individuals not institutions.
- This award is given to an individual in recognition of their outstanding contributions to basic science, translational, or clinical research in ovarian cancer.
- Nominee must hold an MD, PhD, or ScD degree, and must hold an academic appointment at a non-profit medical or research institution.

BrightFocus Foundation – **National Glaucoma Research Request**

 - Standard Awards: grants up to \$200,000 over 2 years

Parkinson's Foundation – **Innovative Parkinson's Research**

- Not limited
- Eligible applicants include scientists with a PhD or MD. Only independent investigators are invited to apply. Applications from instructors who can



demonstrate that they will begin a tenure-track position (as shown by a support letter from their department chair) will be considered.

- Foundation location: Florida & New York
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: October 31, 2024
- Grants up to \$150,000 over 12-18 months
- This grant is designed for researchers both established and new to the PD field, to provide support that will enable researchers to test new ideas with an impact on the PD community and generate compelling results that will facilitate continued investment from the Parkinson's Foundation and other funders. Projects should be "outside the box"

[Melanoma Research Alliance](#) - **Research**

- Geographical giving scope: National and International
- Deadline: October 21, 2024
- Grants up to \$85,000 per year for up to 3 years for their *young investigator award* & grants up to \$75,000 per year for 2 years for their *dermatology career development award*
- They solicit proposals that address the gap in translational science (i.e., turning scientific discoveries into tools and/or treatments for high-risk individuals and patients with melanoma)

- Deadline: September 1st, December 15th, and March 1st
- Awards range between \$10,000 - \$100,000
- The History of Art Grants program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.

Behavioral Health

[American Foundation for Suicide Prevention](#) – Innovation Grants

- Not limited
- Deadline for September 15, 2024 | November 15th, 2024
- Define priorities for funding every two years to stimulate research in understudied areas. Six categories to choose from.
- 2024-2026 research grant priority programs: Ethnic & racial diversity, Understudied populations with elevated suicide rates, survivors of suicide loss.

Education

[Josiah Macy Jr. Foundation](#) – President's Grant

- Not limited
- Deadline: rolling basis
- Awards of no more than \$25,000
- Must check one or more of their priorities:
 - Promoting diversity, equity and belonging
 - Increasing collaboration among future health professionals
 - Prepare future health professionals to navigate ethical dilemmas

Environmental

[Burroughs Wellcome Fund](#) – Climate Change and Human Health Seed Grants

- Not limited
- Deadline: October 24, 2024 | January 23, 2025 | April 24, 2025 | July 24, 2025
- Ranges from \$2,500 - \$50,000
- Interested in activities that build connections between basic/early biomedical scientific approaches and ecological, environmental, geological, geographic, and



planetary-scale thinking, as well as with population-focused fields, including epidemiology and public health, demography, economics, and urban planning.

Health

[WAWA Foundation](#) – **Financial Grants**

- Not limited
- Deadline: January, April, July and October
- LOI related to their areas of focus (Health, Hunger, every day Heroes) can be submitted during the timeframes above. If LOI is approved, additional information may be requested.

Higher Education

[American Philosophical Society](#) - **Franklin Research Grants**

- Not limited, applicants can only submit 1 request for funding for one of the deadlines
- Deadline: October 1, 2024 & December 1, 2024
- Grants up to \$6,500
- Applicants must have a doctorate or published work of doctoral character and quality.
- The program is designed to help meet the costs of travel to libraries and archives for research purposes; the purchase of microfilm, photocopies, or equivalent research materials; the costs associated with fieldwork; or laboratory research expenses

Marine

[Waitt Foundation](#) – **Rapid Ocean Conservation**

- Not limited
- No deadlines. Proposals for grants up to \$20,000 will be reviewed on a monthly rolling basis.
- Will fund projects related to the Waitt Foundation's mission of supporting sustainable fishing and marine protected areas. This includes sub-themes of: Scientific Research, Policy, Management, & Communications.

Medical research

[Foundation for Prader-Willi Research](#) – **FPWR Grant Program**

- Not limited
- Deadline: September 6, 2024
- May request up to \$150,000 in direct costs for an initial 18 months of support.
- Aims to eliminate the challenges of Prader-Willi syndrome through the advancement of research and therapeutic development.



Research

[William T. Grant Foundation](#) – Institutional Challenge grant

- Not limited
- Deadline: September 16, 2024
- \$650,000 over three years
- The grant requires that research institutions shift their policies and practices to value collaborative research.

Sociology

[Sociological Initiatives Foundation](#) – Community-Based Participatory Research Projects

- Not limited
- Deadline: March 7th August 15th
- \$15,000 - \$25,000
- Funds research projects that investigate laws, policies, institutions, regulations, and normative practices that may limit equality in the U.S.
