- Not limited
- Foundation location: California
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: December 1, 2024
- Funding amount ranges between \$100,000 - \$125,000 per year.
- This request is looking for proposals that have the potential to provide data that will inform how to address disparities in educational opportunities associated with race, ethnicity, and family income.

[National Academy of Education](#) – **NAEd/Spencer Postdoctoral Fellowship**

- Foundation location: Washington, D.C
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: November 7, 2024
- 25 scholars will be awarded. Fellows receive \$70,000 for one academic year.
- The research topic must focus primarily on education, but the fellowship welcomes postdocs from any academic discipline or professional field.

[Schlumberger Foundation](#) – **Faculty for the Future**

- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: November 8, 2024
- Grants can be up to USD 50,000 per year for PhD courses and a maximum of USD 40,000 for post-doc research programs.
- This fellowship is for women from developing and emerging economies to pursue PhD or Post-doctoral research in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields at leading universities worldwide.

- Applicant must hold a faculty position with the title of assistant professor, instructor, research assistant professor, or the equivalent.

- \$1.15 million grant distributed over five years.



- This grant supports early to mid-career biomedical researchers and aims to foster a more inclusive scientific environment and ensure that scientific advancements benefit a diverse range of populations.

- The program is designed to help meet the costs of travel to libraries and archives for research purposes; the purchase of microfilm, photocopies, or equivalent



research materials; the costs associated with fieldwork; or laboratory research expenses

Marine

- No deadlines. Proposals for grants up to \$20,000 will be reviewed on a monthly rolling basis.
- Will fund projects related to the Waitt Foundation's mission of supporting sustainable fishing and marine protected areas. This includes sub-themes of: Scientific Research, Policy, Management, & Communications.

Medical research

[Foundation for Prader-Willi Research](#) – **FPWR Grant Program**

- May request up to \$150,000 in direct costs for an initial 18 months of support.
- Aims to eliminate the challenges of Prader-Willi syndrome through the advancement of research and therapeutic development.

- Not limited
- Deadline: September 16, 2024
- \$650,000 over three years
- The grant requires that research institutions shift their policies and practices to value collaborative research.

- Not limited
- Deadline: March 7th August 15th
- \$15,000 - \$25,000
- Funds research projects that investigate laws, policies, institutions, regulations, and normative practices that may limit equality in the U.S.
