- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: November 1, 2024
- There is no max to the grant that can be funded. However, applicants are encouraged to develop realistic budgets that include all expenses needed to implement their projects effectively.
- This foundation has 6 priority areas that focus on improving the quality of life for older people; caregiving, economic security in later life, housing, social and intergenerational connectedness, and organizational capacity building.

- Deadline: October 26, 2024
- A minimum of \$50,000 in funds will be awarded.
- Grants will be awarded in support of projects that investigate and/or educate on the history of chocolate, uncover new chocolate innovations, explore the development of cocoa science, and highlight the chocolate-making process.

- Awards vary, up to \$300,000 over 24 months.

- Geographical giving scope: National & international
- Deadline: December 1, 2024
- Grantees will receive \$75,000
- Applicants should write a grant request demonstrating how they would spend \$75,000 usefully on EIA, predictive impact modeling, and/or engagement efforts with potentially impacted stakeholders. 10 questions must be addressed. See the website for details.

Fellowships

- Foundation location: California
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: November 1, 2024
- The compensation package includes a cost of education allowance, and personal stipends valued at up to \$250,000. Options available.

- This grant program awards fellowships to graduate students pursuing a PhD in the applied physical and biological sciences, mathematics, or engineering.

 [Robert Wood Johnson Foundation](#) – **Health Policy Fellows**

- Not limited
- Foundation location: Washington, D.C
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: November 5, 2024
- \$175,000 stipend over a period of 12-24 months for up to 8 fellows.
- Applicants must have deep experience in a health-related discipline. Examples include but are not limited to medicine; nursing; public health; law; dentistry; economics and other social sciences.
- This program engages midcareer professionals interested in increasing their expertise in health policy.

Higher Education

 [Simons Foundation](#) – **Simons Collaborations in Mathematics and the Physical Sciences Program**

- Not limited
- Foundation location: New York
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: October 31, 2024
- Up to \$2M per year for four years initially. Funding for three additional years may be granted.
- The proposal should specify a core group of PIs; additional PIs may be added after the LOI is approved.
- A Simons Collaboration in MPS should address a mathematical or theoretical topic of fundamental scientific importance, where a significant, new development creates a novel area for exploration or provides a new direction for progress in an established field.

- Deadline: November 1, 2024



- Independent scholars or senior scholars are welcome to apply.
- Grants of up to \$25,000 will be awarded in support of individual research projects.
- This grant aims to support vibrant and significant work that furthers the understanding of what it means to be human. No methodology, research location, topic, or subfield is preferred. The Foundation welcomes proposals integrating two or more subfields and pioneering new approaches and ideas.

- Awarding up to \$15,000 in support for a one-year project. The preceptor must be an ACR or ARP member.
- This award is intended for trainees, junior researchers, or health professionals with no current or prior R01 funding.
- Projects proposed must directly address patient-clinician interactions and communications.

[Aniara Diagnostica](#) – Coagulation Research Grant

- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: November 1, 2024
- This grant awards two \$10,000 yearly grants. 1 for North America & Scandinavia, and 1 global for students/trainees to do innovative coagulation/hematology research.
- Applicants are expected to have Ph.D. or equivalent and be associated with an educational institution. All applicants are expected to have published a minimum of three articles in peer-reviewed scientific journals.

Social Science

[Russell Sage Foundation](#) – Promoting Educational Attainment and Economic Mobility



- Not limited
- Foundation location: New York
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: October 29, 2024
- Trustee grants are capped at \$200,000. Presidential awards are capped at \$75,000.
- The foundation is especially interested in proposals that will advance social science research on the social, political, and economic effects of the Supreme Court decision and the future of race-conscious policies more generally.


 [Russell Sage Foundation](#) – Pipeline Grants Competition

- Not limited
- Foundation location: New York
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: October 22, 2024
- Individual applicants can apply for grants of up to \$35,000; teams of two or more eligible applicants can apply for grants of up to \$50,000.
- This grant prioritizes applications from underrepresented scholars in the social sciences and/or employed at under-resourced colleges and universities. This includes racial, ethnic, gender, disciplinary, institutional, and geographic diversity.

- Not limited



- Foundation location: Washington, D.C
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: October 31, 2024
- A grant amount is not specified, but a detailed budget is required to submit.
- Proposals must address alcohol impairment and understand how these factors impact decision-making and its necessity to identify effective strategies for reducing the incidence of driving while impaired.

 **The Agency Fund – Expand Human Agency**

- Not limited
- Foundation location: California
- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: October 31, 2024
- Investments range from \$10,000 to \$1 million, depending on perceived potential and maturity, with the median around \$200,000.
- This project aims to invest in ideas and organizations that expand human agency (agency is closely related to the concepts of capability, freedom, dignity, and flourishing.) by engaging in people’s consciousness and expanding their ability to exert control over their own lives.

- [Limited](#)
- Deadline: September 1st, December 15th, and March 1st
- Awards range between \$10,000 - \$100,000
- The History of Art Grants program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.

Behavioral Health

[American Foundation for Suicide Prevention](#) – Innovation Grants

- Not limited
- Deadline for September 15, 2024 | November 15th, 2024
- Define priorities for funding every two years to stimulate research in understudied areas. Six categories to choose from.
- 2024-2026 research grant priority programs: Ethnic & racial diversity, Understudied populations with elevated suicide rates, survivors of suicide loss.

Education

[Josiah Macy Jr. Foundation](#) – President's Grant

- Not limited
- Deadline: rolling basis
- Awards of no more than \$25,000
- Must check one or more of their priorities:
 - Promoting diversity, equity and belonging
 - Increasing collaboration among future health professionals
 - Prepare future health professionals to navigate ethical dilemmas

Environmental

[Burroughs Wellcome Fund](#) – Climate Change and Human Health Seed Grants

- Not limited
- Deadline: October 24, 2024 | January 23, 2025 | April 24, 2025 | July 24, 2025
- Ranges from \$2,500 - \$50,000
- Interested in activities that build connections between basic/early biomedical scientific approaches and ecological, environmental, geological, geographic, and



planetary-scale thinking, as well as with population-focused fields, including epidemiology and public health, demography, economics, and urban planning.

Health

[WAWA Foundation](#) – **Financial Grants**

- Not limited
- Deadline: January, April, July and October
- LOI related to their areas of focus (Health, Hunger, every day Heroes) can be submitted during the timeframes above. If LOI is approved, additional information may be requested.

Higher Education

[American Philosophical Society](#) - **Franklin Research Grants**

- Not limited, applicants can only submit 1 request for funding for one of the deadlines
- Deadline: October 1, 2024 & December 1, 2024
- Grants up to \$6,500
- Applicants must have a doctorate or published work of doctoral character and quality.
- The program is designed to help meet the costs of travel to libraries and archives for research purposes; the purchase of microfilm, photocopies, or equivalent research materials; the costs associated with fieldwork; or laboratory research expenses

Marine

[Waitt Foundation](#) – **Rapid Ocean Conservation**

- Not limited
- No deadlines. Proposals for grants up to \$20,000 will be reviewed on a monthly rolling basis.
- Will fund projects related to the Waitt Foundation's mission of supporting sustainable fishing and marine protected areas. This includes sub-themes of: Scientific Research, Policy, Management, & Communications.

Medical research

[Foundation for Prader-Willi Research](#) – **FPWR Grant Program**

- Not limited
- Deadline: September 6, 2024
- May request up to \$150,000 in direct costs for an initial 18 months of support.
- Aims to eliminate the challenges of Prader-Willi syndrome through the advancement of research and therapeutic development.



Research

[William T. Grant Foundation](#) – Institutional Challenge grant

- Not limited
- Deadline: September 16, 2024
- \$650,000 over three years
- The grant requires that research institutions shift their policies and practices to value collaborative research.

Sociology

[Sociological Initiatives Foundation](#) – Community-Based Participatory Research Projects

- Not limited
- Deadline: March 7th August 15th
- \$15,000 - \$25,000
- Funds research projects that investigate laws, policies, institutions, regulations, and normative practices that may limit equality in the U.S.

Other

[Duke Energy](#) – Powering Florida

- [Limited](#) – 1 submission per organization per calendar year
- Deadline: rolling basis throughout the year
- Applications may request \$20,000 or less
- Local Florida Impact Grants work in these areas: Vibrant Economies, Climate Resiliency, Justice, Equity and Inclusion
