### Arts

#### [KRESS](#) – History of Art Grants

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/15
- Grants awarded range from \$10,000 - \$100,000
- This program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.

#### [The Gladys Kriebel Delmas Foundation](#) – Venetian Research Program

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: 12/16
- Grants of up to \$20k for a full academic year.
- This program provides travel grants to individual scholars in support of historical research on Venice and the former Venetian empire and/or for the study of contemporary Venetian society and culture.

### Environment

#### [Temper of the Times Foundation, Inc.](#) – Environmental Advertising

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope:
- Deadline: 12/15
- The foundation will grant between \$5k and \$15k for projects leading to measurable outcomes for wildland ecosystem conservation and restoration in the United States.
- Grants may be used to fund the production of print, radio, or television ads; pay for advertising space or airtime; or produce or distribute pamphlets, books, videos, or press packets.

#### [HCLTech](#) – Climate Action Grant in the Americas

- Not limited



- Geographical giving scope: National and selected countries.
- Deadline: 12/20
- This program will award grants totaling \$1M to 3 organizations in support of scalable, replicable, and sustainable solutions to fight the climate crisis the world is facing today.

## Fellowship

### [American Society of Nephrology](#) – **KidneyCure Pre-Doctoral Fellowship Program**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & international
- Deadline: 12/5
- Providing grants of up to \$30k per year for up to 2 years.
- This program is intended to fund PhD students' original research projects that contribute to understanding kidney biology and disease.

### [Cause Strategy Partners](#) – **Nonprofit Board Fellowship**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 11/6
- This program is designed to connect leaders of color across the U.S. to nonprofit board roles and provide training and support needed to excel.

### [Michael J. Fox Foundation for Parkinson's Research](#) – **The Edmond J. Safra Fellowship**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: 12/5
- The program will award 8 two-year fellowships of \$180k each.
- This program aims to expand the global base of movement disorder specialists by training movement disorder clinician-researchers who can provide expert care and lead scientific advances.

### [Fine Arts Work Center](#) – **2025-2026 Writing Fellowship**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/16
- The grantee will receive a monthly stipend of \$1,250, plus an exit stipend of \$1,000 and it includes an apartment.



- This 7-month fellowship is open to writers in the emerging stages of their careers.

## Health

### [Health Foundation of South Florida](#) – Health Equity Collaboratives

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: South Florida (Broward, Miami-Dade, and Monroe Counties)
- Deadline: 11/22
- This award will fund requests of up to \$100k annually for 2 years.
- The lead for the collaborative should be a healthcare organization, health insurance provider, community-based organization, or social service organization.
- The goal is to address the root causes of health inequities and improve health outcomes for low-income and minority populations.

### [American Nurses Foundation](#) – The Reimagining Nursing Initiative

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 1/10/25
- A total of \$2M will be distributed over the course of two years to select nurse-led teams.
- To be eligible, applicants must be nurse-led teams or nurse-led interdisciplinary teams.

## Higher Education

### [Simons Foundation](#) – Fellows-to-Faculty Award

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: 1/14/25
- This award provides up to 5 years of financial support for a total budget of \$600k.
- This program supports talented early career scientists and their research vision as they transition into tenure-track or equivalent faculty positions.



## Medical Research

### [Rheumatology Research Foundation](#) – Rheumatology Future Physician Scientist Award

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/4
- Granting \$30k for one year with the option for renewal.
- The purpose of this award is to enhance the research training of students who are enrolled in a MD or DO training program.

### [The Plastic Surgery Foundation](#) – Directed Research Grant

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & international
- Deadline: 12/2
- Awarding up to \$50k for projects up to 2 years.
- This award's goal is to support studies designed to assess breast implant safety, including local and systemic complications and related illnesses.

- Awarding up to \$50k to physician-scientist
- This grant supports career development and training dedicated to the study of myocarditis.

- This grant will be awarding \$150k over three years in support of innovative research that focuses on basic science mechanisms of pain.
- To be eligible, the PI must have received committed start-up funds and independent laboratory space from their institution.

### [American Lung Association](#) – Allergic Respiratory Disease Research Award

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: 12/6
- This award provides a \$75k per year grant for up to two years.



- At the time of application, the applicant must hold a doctoral degree and have a full-time faculty or professional appointment equivalent with demonstrated institutional commitment in a Clinical Allergy and Immunology division/section of an academic institution.

 [American Psychological Foundation](#) – **Theodore Blau Early Career Award**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/9
- This grant will award \$2k to a clinical psychologist for accomplishments and promises in clinical psychology.
- Nominees must be early-career psychologists no more than 10 years postdoctoral. Self-nomination is permitted.

 [American Psychological Foundation](#) – **Theodore Millon Grant in Personality Psychology**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/9
- This program will award a \$5,000 grant.
- This program will fund research to advance the science of personality psychology.

 [Rivkin Center for Ovarian Cancer Research](#) – **Pilot Study Awards**

- Deadline: 12/2
- Will award grants of \$75k over 2 years.
- This program intends to support investigator-initiated projects in all areas of ovarian cancer research.

- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/6
- CART typically awards 3-5 grants and expects to offer \$500k to the top grant.
- This grant provides support for the early and conceptual plans of projects that may not yet be supported by extensive preliminary data but have the potential to advance biomedical research substantially.

 [American Kidney Fund](#) – **Clinical Scientist in Nephrology Program**

- Not limited



- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/16
- Grants of up to \$90,000 per year for up to two years will be awarded to support career development.
- The purpose of this program is to improve the quality of care provided to kidney patients and to promote clinical research in nephrology.

- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 11/18
- Emerging Researcher Grant: \$10k will be awarded to assist researchers in conducting research that aligns with their strategic plan.
- Student-Faculty Collaborative Research Grant: \$5k will be awarded in support of faculty members or program directors who oversee ongoing research within their programs.

- Up to \$10k will be awarded in funding.
- This project proposes a collaborative research effort to investigate the physiological and biochemical factors contributing to micturition inhibition in public settings.

- Grantees will receive up to \$200k for up to two years.
- This program funds early-career NF researchers to enable these trainees to become established independent investigators in NF-related fields.

- Deadline: 12/20



- This program aims to fund one research project at \$50k and six projects at \$25k.
- Awards will support clinical or basic science research in arthroscopy or disorders amenable to arthroscopic treatment.

- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 11/6
- Grants of up to \$12,500 will be awarded.
- Grants may be used for a specific program, project, or general operating expenses if related to a specific program or project, to further provide advocacy, education, vocational, or other areas of particular impact to people with psychiatric and/or developmental disabilities.

### [EveryCat Health Foundation](#) – Feline Research

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/13
- Will be awarding grants of up to \$50,000 in support of projects exploring all aspects pertaining to feline health, including shelter medicine, nutrition, and behavior.
- Applicants may be veterinary researchers, faculty veterinarians, post-doctoral fellows, and practicing veterinarians or veterinary students.

- Not limited
- Deadline: September 1<sup>st</sup>, December 15<sup>th</sup>, and March 1<sup>st</sup>
- Awards range between \$10,000 - \$100,000
- The History of Art Grants program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.

### Behavioral Health

#### [American Foundation for Suicide Prevention](#) – Innovation Grants

- Not limited
- Deadline for September 15, 2024 | November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024
- Define priorities for funding every two years to stimulate research in understudied areas. Six categories to choose from.
- 2024-2026 research grant priority programs: Ethnic & racial diversity, Understudied populations with elevated suicide rates, survivors of suicide loss.

### Criminal Justice

- Not limited
- Deadline: on a rolling basis
- This grant aims to bring researchers and practitioners together about solutions to pressing criminal justice problems.
- This grant will support expenses for hosting meetings, travel/lodging, event deliverable production and personnel time for event planning.

- Awards of no more than \$25,000
- Must check one or more of their priorities:
  - Promoting diversity, equity and belonging
  - Increasing collaboration among future health professionals
  - Prepare future health professionals to navigate ethical dilemmas

## Environmental

### [Burroughs Wellcome Fund](#) – **Climate Change and Human Health Seed Grants**

- Not limited
- Deadline: October 24, 2024 | January 23, 2025 | April 24, 2025 | July 24, 2025
- Ranges from \$2,500 - \$50,000
- Interested in activities that build connections between basic/early biomedical scientific approaches and ecological, environmental, geological, geographic, and planetary-scale thinking, as well as with population-focused fields, including epidemiology and public health, demography, economics, and urban planning.

## Health

### [WAWA Foundation](#) – **Financial Grants**

- Not limited
- Deadline: January, April, July and October
- LOI related to their areas of focus (Health, Hunger, every day Heroes) can be submitted during the timeframes above. If LOI is approved, additional information may be requested.

## Higher Education

### [American Philosophical Society](#) - **Franklin Research Grants**

- Not limited, applicants can only submit 1 request for funding for one of the deadlines
- Deadline: October 1, 2024 & December 1, 2024
- Grants up to \$6,500
- Applicants must have a doctorate or published work of doctoral character and quality.
- The program is designed to help meet the costs of travel to libraries and archives for research purposes; the purchase of microfilm, photocopies, or equivalent



research materials; the costs associated with fieldwork; or laboratory research expenses

#### Marine

##### [Waitt Foundation](#) – **Rapid Ocean Conservation**

- Not limited
- No deadlines. Proposals for grants up to \$20,000 will be reviewed on a monthly rolling basis.
- Will fund projects related to the Waitt Foundation's mission of supporting sustainable fishing and marine protected areas. This includes sub-themes of: Scientific Research, Policy, Management, & Communications.

#### Medical research

##### [Foundation for Prader-Willi Research](#) – **FPWR Grant Program**

- Aims to eliminate the challenges of Prader-Willi syndrome through the advancement of research and therapeutic development.

- Not limited
- Deadline: September 16, 2024
- \$650,000 over three years
- The grant requires that research institutions shift their policies and practices to value collaborative research.

##### [Sociological Initiatives Foundation](#) – **Community-Based Participatory Research Projects**

- Not limited
- Deadline: March 7<sup>th</sup> August 15<sup>th</sup>
- \$15,000 - \$25,000
- Funds research projects that investigate laws, policies, institutions, regulations, and normative practices that may limit equality in the U.S.

#### Other

- Limited – 1 submission per organization per calendar year
- Deadline: rolling basis throughout the year



- Applications may request \$20,000 or less
