Animal Welfare

[American Kennel Club Canine Health Foundation](#) – **Rising Research Program**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/31
- Granting a maximum of \$30k.
- This project supports research proposals from outstanding postdoctoral researchers committed to developing into independent scientists focused on advancing dogs' health.

Arts

[Gottlieb foundation](#) – **Individual Support Grant**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: 1/15/2025
- 20 grants are awarded per year. Each award is \$25k.
- Supporting mature painters, sculptors, and printmakers who have been creating art for at least 20 years and who are in financial need.

Environment

[Padi Foundation](#) – **Aquatic Research**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 1/15/2025
- Awarding grants of up to \$12k
- Funds research and education projects that enhance understanding and protection of aquatic environments, including sport diving physics and physiology, and address climate change impacts on coastal and ocean ecosystem.



Fellowship

[CatchLight](#) – Global Fellowship Program

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: 12/14
- This award provides \$30k grants, promotes professional development, and fosters valuable networks and collaborations.
- This program supports innovative visual storytellers seeking to engage broad audiences and amplify the impact of their work through inventive distribution strategies.

[Arthritis Foundation](#) – Rheumatology Fellowship Training

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/4
- Funding \$75k per year for up to 4 years.
- The Arthritis Foundation is seeking applications from institutions developing training programs in clinical rheumatology.

[American Psychological Association](#) – APA Congressional Fellowship

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 1/2/2025
- Stipends for these fellowships range from \$75k - \$90k.
- This Fellowship funds psychologists to spend a year on the staff of a Congress or congressional committee member, contributing to public policy and legislative processes.

[Virginia Center for the Creative Arts](#) – Fully-Funded Fellowships

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 1/15/2025
- Applicants will be considered for a VCCA residency and as many fully-funded fellowships for which they are eligible; only one application with a single application fee is required per deadline.

[WITH Foundation](#) – Programs Serving Adults with Disabilities

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/6
- The foundation grants up to \$150k in support of programs that improve health care delivery to adult consumers with developmental disabilities.
- Research focused grants can be up to \$250k

Higher Education

[American School of Classical Studies at Athens](#) – Hirsh Application

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & Israel
- Deadline: 1/15/2025
- Fellow will receive a stipend of \$11,500 plus room & board, and waiver of school fees.
- This program is for candidates writing their dissertations in archaeology, or early-career scholars.

Medical Research

[American Association for Cancer Research](#) – Waun Ki Hong Scholar Award for Regenerative Cancer Medicine

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: 12/6
- This award provides a two-year grant of \$120k to support the salary and benefits of the fellow. Applicants must have a doctoral degree (PhD, MD, MD/PhD, or equivalent)
- This program encourages and supports postdoctoral or clinical research fellows to conduct highly novel and provocative research in the field of regenerative cancer medicine and to establish a successful career path in this field.

[Alexs Lemonade Stand Foundation for Childhood Cancer](#) – Young Investigator Grant



- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & Canada
- Deadline: 12/12
- A maximum of \$60,000 may be requested per year, for up to 3 years.
- This grant is designed to support early career researchers, such as postdoctoral fellows, clinical fellows, or instructors, pursuing promising childhood cancer research ideas.

[The Elsa U. Pardee Foundation](#) – **Cancer Research**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 12/5
- The average ranges are up to \$200k.
- The foundation encourages one-year proposals, with the goal of fostering the capabilities of new cancer researchers or new cancer approaches by established cancer researchers.

[Cystic Fibrosis Foundation](#) – **Research Grant**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: 12/12
- Awarding \$150k per year for up to three years.
- Priority will be placed on projects that propose better understanding the mechanisms behind disease pathophysiology and developing strategies to prevent or treat CF.

[Pfizer](#) – **Monitoring of Anti-TFPI Therapies in Hemophilia**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National & International
- Deadline: 12/27
- Awarding 2-4 projects that are requesting up to \$50k.
- This program will support preclinical research in hemophilia that aims to investigate strategies to evaluate the hemostatic potential of anti-TFPI therapies.

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: 1/20/2025
- Awarding up to \$90k annually for two consecutive years.



- This program is interested in research in their focus areas to benefit individuals with Neuro-Developmental Disorders (NDD) including Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD).

- Awards grants between \$50k - \$100k.
- This grant funds projects that diversify the digital domain, advance justice and equity in digital scholarly practice, and contribute to public understanding of racial and social justice issues.

- Not limited
- Deadline: September 1st, December 15th, and March 1st
- Awards range between \$10,000 - \$100,000
- The History of Art Grants program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.

Behavioral Health

[American Foundation for Suicide Prevention](#) – Innovation Grants

- Not limited
- Deadline for September 15, 2024 | November 15th, 2024
- Define priorities for funding every two years to stimulate research in understudied areas. Six categories to choose from.
- 2024-2026 research grant priority programs: Ethnic & racial diversity, Understudies populations with elevated suicide rates, survivors of suicide loss.

Criminal Justice

[Arnold Ventures](#) – Innovation Days

- Not limited
- Deadline: on a rolling basis
- This grant aims to bring researchers and practitioners together about solutions to pressing criminal justice problems.
- This grant will support expenses for hosting meetings, travel/lodging, event deliverable production and personnel time for event planning.

[Arnold Ventures](#) – Causal Research on Community Safety and the Criminal Justice

- Not limited
- Deadline: LOIs can be submitted at any time.
- Median budget of \$500,000 to fund for a 3-4 year period.
- This proposal seeks LOIs to conduct causal research projects of policies, practices, and interventions related to community safety and the criminal justice system.

- Not limited
- Deadline: rolling basis
- Awards of no more than \$25,000
- Must check one or more of their priorities:
 - Promoting diversity, equity and belonging
 - Increasing collaboration among future health professionals
 - Prepare future health professionals to navigate ethical dilemmas

Environmental

[Burroughs Wellcome Fund](#) – **Climate Change and Human Health Seed Grants**

- Not limited
- Deadline: October 24, 2024 | January 23, 2025 | April 24, 2025 | July 24, 2025
- Ranges from \$2,500 - \$50,000
- Interested in activities that build connections between basic/early biomedical scientific approaches and ecological, environmental, geological, geographic, and planetary-scale thinking, as well as with population-focused fields, including epidemiology and public health, demography, economics, and urban planning.

Fellowships

[Virginia Center for the Creative Arts](#) – **Fully-Funded Fellowships**

- Not limited
- Geographical giving scope: National
- Deadline: January 15, 2025 | May 15, 2025 | September 15, 2025
- Applicants will be considered for a VCCA residency and as many fully-funded fellowships for which they are eligible; only one application with a single application fee is required per deadline.

Health

[WAWA Foundation](#) – **Financial Grants**

- Not limited
- Deadline: January, April, July and October
- LOI related to their areas of focus (Health, Hunger, every day Heroes) can be submitted during the timeframes above. If LOI is approved, additional information may be requested.



Higher Education

[American Philosophical Society](#) - Franklin Research Grants

- Not limited, applicants can only submit 1 request for funding for one of the deadlines
- Deadline: October 1, 2024 & December 1, 2024
- Grants up to \$6,500
- Applicants must have a doctorate or published work of doctoral character and quality.
- The program is designed to help meet the costs of travel to libraries and archives for research purposes; the purchase of microfilm, photocopies, or equivalent research materials; the costs associated with fieldwork; or laboratory research expenses

Marine

[Waitt Foundation](#) – Rapid Ocean Conservation

- Not limited
- No deadlines. Proposals for grants up to \$20,000 will be reviewed on a monthly rolling basis.
- Will fund projects related to the Waitt Foundation's mission of supporting sustainable fishing and marine protected areas. This includes sub-themes of: Scientific Research, Policy, Management, & Communications.

Medical research

[Foundation for Prader-Willi Research](#) – FPWR Grant Program

- Not limited
- Deadline: September 6, 2024
- May request up to \$150,000 in direct costs for an initial 18 months of support.
- Aims to eliminate the challenges of Prader-Willi syndrome through the advancement of research and therapeutic development.

[The Elsa U. Pardee Foundation](#) – Cancer Research

- Not limited
- Deadline: December 15, April 30, August 31
- Funds ranges up to \$200,000.
- The foundation encourages one-year proposals, with the goal of fostering the capabilities of new cancer researchers or new cancer approaches by established cancer researchers.



Research

[William T. Grant Foundation](#) – Institutional Challenge grant

- Not limited
- Deadline: September 16, 2024
- \$650,000 over three years
- The grant requires that research institutions shift their policies and practices to value collaborative research.

- Not limited
- Deadline: March 7th August 15th
- \$15,000 - \$25,000
- Funds research projects that investigate laws, policies, institutions, regulations, and normative practices that may limit equality in the U.S.
