Arts

[Simons Foundation](#) – **Symmetry: A Call for Artists, Scientists and Arts Organizations**

- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: February 20, 2025
- Awarding a \$30k grant per participating team.
- This expanded program, called Open Interval, supports dedicated periods of thought partnership and exploration, fostering creative collaborations across various disciplines.

[South Arts](#) – **Southern Prize and State Fellowship for Visual Arts**

- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: AL, FL, GA, KY, LA, MS, NC, SC, TN.
- Deadline: February 12, 2025
- There will be one \$25k award and a runner-up prize of \$10k.
- This is a state-specific prize awarded to artists whose work reflects the best visual arts in the South. A national jury will select one awardee per eligible state, based on artistic excellence that reflects and represents the region's diversity of artistic expression.

[KRESS](#) – **History of Art Grants**

- Not limited – Each university is limited to two nominees per academic department.
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: LOI due March 1, 2025
- Awards range between \$10,000 - \$100,000
- The History of Art Grants program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.

[Foundation for Food & Agriculture Research](#) – Sustainable Food Systems Initiative:

Focus on Food

- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: February 14, 2025
- Their 2025-2027 initiative commits \$410k in funding for eight grants. Each receiving \$50k
- Grantees will design, implement and evaluate actionable community-based projects for sustainable food systems that improve human health and nutrition.

[Foundation for Food & Agriculture Research](#) – New Innovator in Food & Agriculture

Research Award

- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: February 19, 2025
- Applicants are eligible for up to \$150k per year for up to three years.
- The goal of this award is to launch the careers of promising scientists whose research addresses significant food and agriculture challenges.

Athletics

[American Medical Society for Sports Medicine](#) – Minority Research Grant Award

- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: February 14, 2025
- Awarding a \$10k grant.
- This program aims to provide research opportunities for historically underrepresented minorities in biomedical research to advance representation across diverse backgrounds and promote health equity in sports medicine research.

Fellowship

[Foundation for Food & Agriculture Research](#) – Fellows Program



- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National & Canada
- Deadline: February 22, 2025
- Fellows will receive \$65k annually for three years.
- The fellowship program offers leadership and professional development training to PhD students studying food and agriculture-related sciences.

 [Howard Hughes Medical Institute](#) – **Hanna H. Gray Fellows Program**


- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: February 22, 2025
- Fellows receive up to \$1.5M in support over an eight-year period.
- The 2025 competition is open to researchers and physician-scientists in the biological and biomedical sciences in many scientific disciplines.

Health

 [Robert Wood Johnson Foundation](#) - **Reimagining Land Use & Zoning for Health Equity**

- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National & Canada
- Deadline: LOI due February 6, 2025
- Up to 10 awards will be funded at \$250k each.
- This request identifies and supports existing and ongoing work in the demonstration (pilot), implementation, or evaluation stage rather than the concept, startup, or initiation phases. This work focuses on creating equitable approaches to how communities are planned, revitalized, and built.

Medical Research

 [Cure Childhood Cancer](#) – **Childhood Cancer Research**

- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: LOI due February 14, 2025
- CURE offers two different types of research grants:
 - *Translations to CURE Award:* For PIs at any stage in their careers and will award up to two years a total of \$330k



- *Early Investigator Award*: For beginning scientists at the instructor or assistant professor level and will award up to two years a total of \$220k

 [OREF](#) – **Goldberg Arthritis Research Grant**

- Not Limited - Only 1 submission per PI
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: February 13, 2025
- Awarding \$50k
- This is a seed grant for start-up promising research projects that address issues related to the treatment of arthritis.

 [National Kidney Foundation](#) – **Kidney Health Equity Community Engagement Award**

- Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: February 10, 2025
- Awarding \$75k for one year.
- This award is looking to influence health equity related to kidney health at a community level. They're looking for applications that seek to improve access to kidney care, while improving kidney disease management and patient outcome.

 [American Shoulder and Elbow Surgeons Foundation](#) – **Research Grant**

- Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: February 21, 2025
- A grant of up to \$20k for 12-24 months.
- This is a seed grant for promising shoulder and elbow research projects.

 [International OCD Foundation](#) – **Research Grant Programs**

- Geographical Giving Scope: National & International
- Deadline: February 28, 2025
- There are two awards within this program:
 - Innovator Award: offers a three-year grant of up to \$300k to support senior researchers pursuing high-impact research into OCD.
 - Michale A. Jenike Young Investigator Award: grants of up to \$50k to support promising young investigators who are developing their careers while creating impactful research projects on OCD.

- Deadline: March 7, 2025
- Awarding up to two \$150k grants supporting new and innovative projects.
- The foundation is particularly interested in applicants who have identified a defined approach to improving diagnostics or therapeutics for Lyme disease.

- Applicants can request up to \$5k.
- The goal of this grant is to support innovative training opportunities, workforce development, and collaborations across disciplines.

Technology

 [Schmidt Sciences](#) – **Decarbonization and Energy Virtual Institute**

- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National & International
- Deadline: LOI due February 14, 2025
- Two categories of projects: sectoral modeling efforts up to \$3 million over five years and economy-wide modeling efforts on coupling models from different sectors and scales up to \$10 million over five years.
- The goal of this grant is to support transformative research that advances the state of the art in computational models to accurately represent, predict and evaluate energy transition pathways and their varied needs and impacts.

- Not Limited – 1 submission per PI
- Geographical Giving Scope: National & International
- Deadline: February 10, 2025
- Grantees will receive awards ranging from \$500K - \$2M and six months of structured support from Google.
- This program is interested in AI-powered solutions that focus on three areas:
 - Knowledge, skills, and learning
 - Scientific advancement
 - Resilient communities

Arts

- [KRESS](#) – **History of Art Grants**
 - Not limited – Each university is limited to two nominees per academic department.
 - Deadline: LOI due March 1, 2025
 - Awards range between \$10,000 - \$100,000
 - The History of Art Grants program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.

Criminal Justice

- [Arnold Ventures](#) – **Innovation Days**
 - Not limited
 - Deadline: on a rolling basis
 - This grant aims to bring researchers and practitioners together about solutions to pressing criminal justice problems.
 - This grant will support expenses for hosting meetings, travel/lodging, event deliverable production and personnel time for event planning.
- [Arnold Ventures](#) – **Causal Research on Community Safety and the Criminal Justice System**
 - Not limited
 - Deadline: LOIs can be submitted at any time.
 - Median budget of \$500,000 to fund for a 3-4 year period.
 - This proposal seeks LOIs to conduct causal research projects of policies, practices, and interventions related to community safety and the criminal justice system.

 - Not limited
 - Deadline: rolling basis
 - Awards of no more than \$25,000
 - Must check one or more of their priorities:
 - Promoting diversity, equity and belonging
 - Increasing collaboration among future health professionals



- Prepare future health professionals to navigate ethical dilemmas

Environmental

- [Burroughs Wellcome Fund](#) – **Climate Change and Human Health Seed Grants**
 - Not limited
 - Deadline: October 24, 2024 | January 23, 2025 | April 24, 2025 | July 24, 2025
 - Ranges from \$2,500 - \$50,000
 - Interested in activities that build connections between basic/early biomedical scientific approaches and ecological, environmental, geological, geographic, and planetary-scale thinking, as well as with population-focused fields, including epidemiology and public health, demography, economics, and urban planning.

Fellowships

- [Virginia Center for the Creative Arts](#) – **Fully-Funded Fellowships**
 - Not limited
 - Geographical giving scope: National
 - Deadline: January 15, 2025 | May 15, 2025 | September 15, 2025
 - Applicants will be considered for a VCCA residency and as many fully-funded fellowships for which they are eligible; only one application with a single application fee is required per deadline.

Health


- [WAWA Foundation](#) – **Financial Grants**
 - Not limited
 - Deadline: January, April, July and October
 - LOI related to their areas of focus (Health, Hunger, every day Heroes) can be submitted during the timeframes above. If LOI is approved, additional information may be requested.
- [Robert Wood Johnson Foundation](#) – **Evidence for Action: Innovative Research to Advance Racial Equity**
 - Not limited
 - Deadline: Rolling
 - There is no specific amount range for allowable budget requests.
 - This funding is focused on studies about upstream causes of health inequities, such as the systems, structures, laws, policies, norms, and practices that determine the distribution of resources and opportunities.




Marine

- [Waitt Foundation](#) – **Rapid Ocean Conservation**
 - Not limited
 - Deadline: Proposals for grants up to \$20,000 will be reviewed on a monthly rolling basis.
 - Will fund projects related to the Waitt Foundation's mission of supporting sustainable fishing and marine protected areas. This includes sub-themes of: Scientific Research, Policy, Management, & Communications.

Medical Research

-  [Foundation for Prader-Willi Research](#) – **FPWR Grant Program**
 - Not limited
 - Deadline: LOI due February 28, 2025 | September 5, 2025
 - May request up to \$150,000 in direct costs for an initial 18 months of support.
 - Aims to eliminate the challenges of Prader-Willi syndrome through the advancement of research and therapeutic development.

-  [The Elsa U. Pardee Foundation](#) – **Cancer Research**
 - Not limited
 - Deadline: December 15, April 30, August 31
 - Funds ranges up to \$200,000.
 - The foundation encourages one-year proposals, with the goal of fostering the capabilities of new cancer researchers or new cancer approaches by established cancer researchers.

Other

- [Duke Energy](#) – **Powering Florida**
 - Limited – 1 submission per organization per calendar year
 - Deadline: rolling basis throughout the year
 - Applications may request \$20,000 or less
