Aging

Roybal Center for Elder Mistreatment Intervention Research – Research Projects

- o <u>Not limited</u>
- o <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- <u>Deadline:</u> February 12, 2025
- The center commits \$300k annually to fund 1-3 grantees.
- Projects aimed at advancing research on interventions for elder mistreatment, including interventions to prevent the negative health and mental health consequences of elder mistreatment.

Mational Academy of Medicine – 2025 Catalyst Award Competition

- o <u>Not limited</u>
- o <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- <u>Deadline:</u> March 4, 2025
- Awarding up to 15 grants of \$50k each.
- This foundation is currently seeking bold, new, and innovative ideas that aim to extend the human health span.

Arts

KRESS Foundation – **History of Art Grants**

- o <u>Not limited</u>
- <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- <u>Deadline:</u> LOI due March 1, 2025
- Awards range between \$10,000 \$100,000
- The History of Art Grants program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.
- Suild of Carillonneurs in North America Ronald Barnes Memorial Grant
 - Not limited
 - <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
 - o <u>Deadline:</u> March 1, 2025



- Grants of up to \$14,138, depending on the number of applicants.
- This grant is to support the development of proficient carillonneurs, encourage new carillons, and improve the existing installations.

Community Improvement

- Mational Council on Problem Gambling Agility Grants
 - o <u>Not Limited</u>
 - <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
 - o <u>Deadline:</u> February 26, 2025
 - The foundation will award a maximum of \$40k in efforts to implement and expand problem gambling prevention programs in communities.

Education

American Psychological Foundation – Esther Katz Rosen Fund Grants

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- o Deadline: March 5, 2025
- A grant of \$45k will be awarded to support activities on the advancement and application of knowledge related to identified gifted and talented children and adolescents, including research, pilot projects, and research-based programs.

Health

Robert Wood Johnson Foundation – Health Policy Research Scholars

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- o <u>Geographical Giving Scope</u>: National
- o Deadline: March 11, 2025
- \circ Up to 40 scholars will be selected to receive \$30k for up to four years.
- Applicants must be starting full-time, second-year doctoral studies in fall 2025.
- The program is for doctoral students who are deeply committed to research that works to advance antiracism and structural change work aligned with the health needs of the most impacted communities.

Robert Wood Johnson Foundation – Local Data for equitable Communities



- o <u>Universities must partner with a non-profit</u>
- <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- o <u>Deadline:</u> March 18, 2025
- The foundation expects to award up to 30 grants of \$50k each.
- This proposal aims to leverage local data to identify and address inequities in communities' physical, economic, and social conditions. The goal is to improve health outcomes by promoting health equity through data-driven strategies.

Journalism

International Center for Journalists – Arthur F. Burns Fellowship

- o Not Limited
- o <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National & International
- o Deadline: March 1, 2025
- This 9-week exchange program in Germany includes a \$4k stipend to cover expenses and an additional \$1,500 for travel expenses.
- Fellows will learn first-hand about their host country and media outlet, write stories, and produce broadcasts for host and home audiences.

Medical Research

Simons Foundation – Autism Rat models Consortium

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- o <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- o <u>Deadline:</u> March 6, 2025
- There are 2 options within this application
 - Explorer: for those who have experience studying rat models but are new to studying autism or are focused on a functional domain that is not well represented in existing projects.
 - Collaboration: for multi-lab collaborative projects that are based on existing work in autism/NDD relevant rat models.
- Explorer's total budget is \$200k, which includes 20% indirect costs for each funding year over two years.



• Collaboration total budget is \$300k, which includes 20% indirect costs, for each year over three to four years.

Society for Vascular Surgery Foundation – Clinical Research Seed Grant

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- o <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- o <u>Deadline:</u> March 1, 2025
- Grantee will receive \$25k to support clinical research, preferably patientoriented.
- The purpose of this grant is to fund research that leads to the discovery of knowledge and innovative strategies to prevent and treat circulatory disease.

Vera and Joseph Dresner Foundation – MDS Research Fund

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- Deadline: LOI due March 7, 2025
- Proposals should address one or more of the following areas within MDS or related conditions: etiology (including epidemiology, exposures, and/or genetic predisposition), biology, genetics/genomics, prognosis, treatment, symptom management, quality of life/patient-reported outcomes, or survivorship.
- The fund will facilitate the advancement of innovative basic science, translational or clinical research. The foundation will accept proposals of two types:
 - Early Career Awards: a single award of \$200k/year or more
 - Established Investigator Awards: funding up to \$250k/year for 2 years.

Bay Area Lyme Foundation – Emerging Leader Awards

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- o <u>Deadline:</u> March 7, 2025
- Awarding up to two \$150k grants.
- The foundation is interested in supporting new and innovative projects aiming to attract aspiring new scientific talent.

Hearing Health Foundation – Emerging Research Grants

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- <u>Deadline</u>: LOI (eligibility quiz) must be completed first and it is due February 27, 2025. Full Application due March 3, 2025.
- Awarding up to \$50k over a year of research.



 This grant is for researchers early in their careers who are focused on hearing loss, hearing restoration, and hearing balance-related conditions. Application must hold an AuD, MD, PhD, or equivalent degree.

Mational Academy of Medicine – 2025 Catalyst Award Competition

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- <u>Deadline:</u> March 4, 2025
- Each Catalyst Award includes a \$50,000 cash prize as well as exclusive access to additional funding opportunities, occasions to connect and collaborate with innovators from around the world, amplification of the award and winning idea, and resources to enhance your project and professional development.
- The foundation is seeking new and innovative ideas that aim to extend the human health span. Applications can come from a combination of fields, see link for more details.

American Association for Cancer Research – "I'm In" Oncodisparity Fellowships in Lung and Urothelial Cancer

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- o <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- o Deadline: March 18, 2025
- Awardee will receive a one-year grant of \$65k to support the salary and benefits of the fellow.
- Proposed research should specifically address disparities in oncology care in the area of non-small cell lung cancer or advanced urothelial carcinoma care and address barriers leading to inequality of cancer care that exist in institutions and within society at large.

Public/Private Partnerships

U.S National Science Foundation – Partnership to Advance Conservation Science and Practice Program

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- o <u>Deadline:</u> March 17, 2025
- The foundation has \$16 Million available for FY25 and estimates awarding 8-16 projects for up to five years.



 The program invites proposals involving implementing conservation activities based on conservation science principles via partnerships with academic conservation organizations.

Science

WAE Research Program for Rain Enhancement Science - Research

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- o <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National & International
- <u>Deadline:</u> Register by March 13, 2025. Registration required pre-proposal.
- Up to three awards of up to \$1.5M over three years will be awarded.
- The PI must have substantial research and management experience in the associated field of science and/or engineering to lead the Project.
- For the 6th cycle, the program is focusing on five strategic elements:
 - Optimized seeding materials
 - Novel cloud formation and/or rain enhancement systems
 - Autonomous Unmanned Aircraft Systems
 - Limited-Area Climate Interventions
 - Advanced models, software, and data.

American Chemical Society – Research Grant Programs

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- o <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National & International
- Deadline: March 7, 2025
- This foundation supports fundamental research in the petroleum field as well as the development of the next generation of engineers and scientists through advanced scientific education.
- Grant amounts vary by the program:
 - New directions for PhD faculty; \$125k over two years
 - Doctoral New Investigator for faculty within their first 3 years; \$110k over two years.
 - Undergraduate research for non-doctoral departments; \$70k over three years.
 - Undergraduate New Investigator for non-doctoral faculty within 5 years;
 \$55k over two years.



Social Justice

American Council of Learned Societies – Leading Edge Fellowships

- o <u>Not Limited</u>
- <u>Geographical Giving Scope:</u> National
- o <u>Deadline:</u> March 12, 2025
- The fellowship will include a stipend: for remote positions, \$70,000 in year one, and \$72,000 in year two; for in-person positions, \$72,000 in year one, and \$74,000 in year two
- This fellowship program aims to place recent humanities PhDs with nonprofit organizations committed to promoting social justice in their communities.

Arts

- <u>KRESS Foundation</u> History of Art Grants
 - o <u>Not limited</u>
 - <u>Deadline:</u> LOI due March 1, 2025
 - Awards range between \$10,000 \$100,000
 - The History of Art Grants program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.

Criminal Justice

- <u>Arnold Ventures</u> Innovation Days
 - o <u>Not limited</u>
 - <u>Deadline:</u> on a rolling basis
 - This grant aims to bring researchers and practitioners together about solutions to pressing criminal justice problems.
 - This grant will support expenses for hosting meetings, travel/lodging, event deliverable production and personnel time for event planning.
- <u>Arnold Ventures</u> Causal Research on Community Safety and the Criminal Justice

System

- <u>Deadline:</u> LOIs can be submitted at any time.
- Median budget of \$500,000 to fund for a 3-4 year period.
- This proposal seeks LOIs to conduct causal research projects of policies, practices, and interventions related to community safety and the criminal justice system.

Education

- Josiah Macy Jr. Foundation President's Grant
 - o <u>Not limited</u>
 - <u>Deadline:</u> rolling basis
 - Awards of no more than \$25,000
 - Must check one or more of their priorities:
 - Promoting diversity, equity and belonging
 - Increasing collaboration among future health professionals
 - Prepare future health professionals to navigate ethical dilemmas



Environmental

- <u>Burroughs Wellcome Fund</u> Climate Change and Human Health Seed Grants
 - o <u>Not limited</u>
 - o <u>Deadline:</u> October 24, 2024 | January 23, 2025 | April 24, 2025 | July 24, 2025
 - Ranges from \$2,500 \$50,000
 - Interested in activities that build connections between basic/early biomedical scientific approaches and ecological, environmental, geological, geographic, and planetary-scale thinking, as well as with population-focused fields, including epidemiology and public health, demography, economics, and urban planning.

Fellowships

- <u>Virginia Center for the Creative Arts</u> Fully-Funded Fellowships
 - o <u>Not limited</u>
 - <u>Geographical giving scope:</u> National
 - o <u>Deadline:</u> January 15, 2025 | May 15, 2025 | September 15, 2025
 - Applicants will be considered for a VCCA residency and as many fully-funded fellowships for which they are eligible; only one application with a single application fee is required per deadline.

Health

- <u>WAWA Foundation</u> Financial Grants
 - o <u>Not limited</u>
 - o <u>Deadline:</u> January, April, July and October
 - LOI related to their areas of focus (Health, Hunger, every day Heroes) can be submitted during the timeframes above. If LOI is approved, additional information may be requested.
- <u>Robert Wood Johnson Foundation</u> Evidence for Action: Innovative Research to Advance Racial Equity
 - o <u>Not limited</u>
 - o <u>Deadline:</u> Rolling
 - \circ $\;$ There is no specific amount range for allowable budget requests.
 - This funding is focused on studies about upstream causes of health inequities, such as the systems, structures, laws, policies, norms, and practices that determine the distribution of resources and opportunities.



Marine

- <u>Waitt Foundation</u> Rapid Ocean Conservation
 - o <u>Not limited</u>
 - <u>Deadline</u>: Proposals for grants up to \$20,000 will be reviewed on a <u>monthly</u> rolling basis.
 - Will fund projects related to the Waitt Foundation's mission of supporting sustainable fishing and marine protected areas. This includes sub-themes of: Scientific Research, Policy, Management, & Communications.

Medical Research

Foundation for Prader-Willi Research – FPWR Grant Program

- o <u>Not limited</u>
- o <u>Deadline:</u> LOI due February 28, 2025 | September 5, 2025
- May request up to \$150,000 in direct costs for an initial 18 months of support.
- Aims to eliminate the challenges of Prader-Willi syndrome through the advancement of research and therapeutic development.

The Elsa U. Pardee Foundation – Cancer Research

- o <u>Not limited</u>
- o <u>Deadline:</u> December 15, April 30, August 31
- Funds ranges up to \$200,000.
- The foundation encourages one-year proposals, with the goal of fostering the capabilities of new cancer researchers or new cancer approaches by established cancer researchers.

Other

• <u>Duke Energy</u> – Powering Florida

- <u>Limited</u> 1 submission per organization per calendar year
- o <u>Deadline:</u> rolling basis throughout the year
- Applications may request \$20,000 or less
- Local Florida Impact Grants work in these areas: Vibrant Economies, Climate Resiliency, Justice, Equity and Inclusion

Sociology

- <u>Sociological Initiatives Foundation</u> Community-Based Participatory Research Projects
 - o Not limited
 - <u>Deadline:</u> August 15, 2025
 - Grant amounts range from \$15k \$25k



• This proposal is for community-academic partnerships that combine research with concrete social action strategies, prioritizing projects that promote racial justice and equitable laws, policies, and practices.
