# Climate Change

- Frankenthaler Climate Initiative 2025 Grant Cycle
  - o Not limited
  - o Geographical Giving Scope: National
  - o Deadline: March 28, 2025
  - This foundation provides visual arts institutions grants to undertake ambitious sustainability and energy efficiency initiatives that directly address carbon reduction and energy efficiency. There are a few categories to choose from;
    - Catalyst grants; \$15k to support stand-alone projects with a quick turnaround.
    - Scoping grants; \$25k to support initial assessments performed by independent consultants.
    - Technical Assistance grants; \$50k to support projects that have finished assessments but need procurement for an identified efficiency project.

## Environmental



- Not limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: LOI due March 1, 2025
- Applicant may apply for a minimum of \$50k and a maximum of \$75k for this onyear grant opportunity.
- Two funding priorities:
  - Habitat Enhancement Projects: projects should directly support the creation, restoration, remediation, improvement, and/or protection of habitats for important pollinator species such as butterflies, bees, bats, and more.
  - Community Engagement: Projects must provide opportunities for public engagement through education or volunteer-focused events.



# Fellowship

- Damon Runyon Cancer Research Foundation Fellowship Award
  - Not limited
  - o Geographical Giving Scope: National
  - o Deadline: March 17, 2025
  - Fellowships are granted a four-year term, first year stipend is \$70k with second-, third-, and fourth-year funding contingent on satisfactory progress reports.
  - Applicants must have completed one or more of the following degrees or its equivalent: MD, PhD, MD/PhD, DDS, DVM, DO.
  - This award supports theoretical and experimental research relevant to the study of cancer and the search for its causes, mechanisms, therapies, and prevention.
- mfAR Mathilde Krim Fellowships in Biomedical Research
  - o Not limited
  - o Geographical Giving Scope: National & International
  - o Deadline: Registration is required by March 19, 2025. LOI due March 27, 2025
  - O Maximum funding for phase 1 is \$180k and phase 2 is \$50k
  - The fellowship is designed to help outstanding young scientists with innovative ideas transition to an independent career in HIV/AIDS research.

## Health

- Kent Richard Hofmann Foundation LOIs for HIV/AIDS Efforts
  - Not limited
  - Geographical Giving Scope: National
  - Deadline: LOI due February 28, 2025
  - Grant amounts vary from \$1k \$8k.
  - Grants are made in support of:
    - Care and direct services
    - Education
    - Research
- Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Local Data for Equitable Communities
  - o <u>Universities are only eligible to apply with a partnership.</u>
  - Geographical Giving Scope: National
  - o Deadline: March 18, 2025



- The foundation expects to award up to 30 grants of \$50k each.
- The goals of the grant program are:
  - To inform public policy and improve the physical, social, and economic conditions of places.
  - Build local capacity to use data for action.
  - Strengthen the use of equitable data practices.
  - Document successful practices for more communities to learn from and adapt.

### The Doctors Company Foundation – Patient Safety Research

- Not limited
- o Geographical Giving Scope: National
- o Deadline: LOI due March 19, 2025
- The grant amount ranges from \$25k \$240,000
- Projects aiming to reduce healthcare costs while improving patient safety are encouraged. The foundation will fund only the direct costs associated with a project

## PCORI – Engagement Award: Capacity Building

- Not limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- o Deadline: April 1, 2025
- Supporting projects for up to \$300k that will last up to two years.

## PCORI – Engagement Award: Dissemination Initiative

- Not limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- o Deadline: April 1, 2025
- Supporting projects for up to \$300k that will last up to two years.
- Then foundation is interested in projects that focus on active dissemination that spreads awareness and increases knowledge of PCORI-funded research findings.

## PCORI – Engagement Award: Convening Support

- Not limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: April 1, 2025



Supporting projects for up to \$150k that will last up to one year.

### Merican Society of Clinical Oncology – Young Investigator Award

- Not limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National & International
- o Deadline: March 13, 2025
- A one-year \$50k grant will be awarded to support personnel, travel to attend the Conquer Cancer grants, and/or research expenses.
- This award provides funding to promising investigators to encourage and promote quality research in clinical oncology.

### Organization for Autism Research - Applied Research Competition

- o Limited
- o Geographical Giving Scope: National & International
- o Deadline: LOI due March 17, 2025
- Up to \$50k for studies from 1-2 years.
- OAR has placed special emphasis on research addressing the following areas: community-based assessment and intervention; community-engaged research; community living and supports; gender, reproductive, and sexual health; improving access to and effectiveness of existing systems and services; intersectionality, equity and diversity; mid-life and older adults; physical health and mental health.

## Cure Sanfilippo Foundation – Sanfilippo Syndrome Research

- Not limited
- o Geographical Giving Scope: National
- o <u>Deadline:</u> LOI due March 28, 2025
- Priority areas for this submission period include proposals seeking collaborative research with the foundation to advance the clinical understanding, diagnosis, measurement tools, and management of movement disorders in individuals with Sanfilippo syndromes.
- o Proposal will be considered under 2 mechanisms:
  - Pilot funding; grants of up to \$50k per year for up to 2 years.
  - Advance funding; grants of \$51k or more per year to support a larger scope of work and funding need.
- Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation Innovations for Gram-Negative Antibiotic Discovery



- Not limited
- o Geographical Giving Scope: National & International
- o Deadline: LOI due March 25, 2025. Webinar on February 27, 2025 at 9am est.
- Projects with a duration of up to three years and a maximum requested budget of \$5 million are eligible for funding.
- The ultimate objective of this proposal is to enable discovery of safe and simple first-line broad-spectrum drugs for syndromic management.
- Thrasher Research Fund Concept Papers for Pediatric Research
  - Not limited
  - o Geographical Giving Scope: National
  - <u>Deadline</u>: Concept Papers due March 18, 2025
  - Grants of up to \$25k will be awarded to new researchers to encourage the development of researchers in child health.

# Science / Technology

- Sigma XI, The Scientific Research Honor Society Grants in Aid of Research
  - Not limited
  - o Geographical Giving Scope: National
  - o Deadline: March 15, 2025
  - Award amounts of Sigma XI members range from \$500-\$5,000 for graduate applicants. \$200 - \$2,000 for undergraduate applicants.
  - Sigma Xi strongly encourages applications from women and underrepresented minorities, including Blacks or African Americans, Hispanics or Latinx, Native Americans, Alaskan Natives, or Native Hawaiians.
  - Application decisions are based on the strength of three key elements of a grant proposal: proposed investigation, Budget, and a Recommendation from the Research Advisor

## Veterans

- The Fisher House Foundation Fisher Service Award
  - Not limited
  - o Geographical Giving Scope: National
  - Deadline: March 6, 2025



- o \$400k is divided among the top programs.
- This award recognizes innovative programs that support and strengthen the military and veteran communities. The programs should improve the quality of life for active duty, reserve, or National Guard, and/or veterans and their families.



# Recurring

#### Arts

- <u>KRESS Foundation</u> History of Art Grants
  - o Not limited
  - o Deadline: LOI due March 1, 2025
  - Awards range between \$10,000 \$100,000
  - The History of Art Grants program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.

### **Criminal Justice**

- <u>Arnold Ventures</u> **Innovation Days** 
  - o Not limited
  - Deadline: on a rolling basis
  - This grant aims to bring researchers and practitioners together about solutions to pressing criminal justice problems.
  - This grant will support expenses for hosting meetings, travel/lodging, event deliverable production and personnel time for event planning.
- Arnold Ventures Causal Research on Community Safety and the Criminal Justice
  System
  - Not limited
  - Deadline: LOIs can be submitted at any time.
  - Median budget of \$500,000 to fund for a 3-4 year period.
  - This proposal seeks LOIs to conduct causal research projects of policies, practices, and interventions related to community safety and the criminal justice system.

#### Education

- <u>Josiah Macy Jr. Foundation</u> **President's Grant** 
  - Not limited
  - <u>Deadline</u>: rolling basis
  - Awards of no more than \$25,000
  - Must check one or more of their priorities:
    - Promoting diversity, equity and belonging
    - Increasing collaboration among future health professionals
    - Prepare future health professionals to navigate ethical dilemmas



#### Environmental

- Burroughs Wellcome Fund Climate Change and Human Health Seed Grants
  - Not limited
  - o <u>Deadline:</u> October 24, 2024 | January 23, 2025 | April 24, 2025 | July 24, 2025
  - o Ranges from \$2,500 \$50,000
  - o Interested in activities that build connections between basic/early biomedical scientific approaches and ecological, environmental, geological, geographic, and planetary-scale thinking, as well as with population-focused fields, including epidemiology and public health, demography, economics, and urban planning.

### Fellowships

- Virginia Center for the Creative Arts Fully-Funded Fellowships
  - Not limited
  - o Geographical giving scope: National
  - o Deadline: January 15, 2025 | May 15, 2025 | September 15, 2025
  - Applicants will be considered for a VCCA residency and as many fully-funded fellowships for which they are eligible; only one application with a single application fee is required per deadline.

#### Health

- <u>WAWA Foundation</u> **Financial Grants** 
  - Not limited
  - <u>Deadline</u>: January, April, July and October
  - LOI related to their areas of focus (Health, Hunger, every day Heroes) can be submitted during the timeframes above. If LOI is approved, additional information may be requested.
- Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Evidence for Action: Innovative Research to Advance Racial Equity
  - Not limited
  - Deadline: Rolling
  - There is no specific amount range for allowable budget requests.
  - This funding is focused on studies about upstream causes of health inequities, such as the systems, structures, laws, policies, norms, and practices that determine the distribution of resources and opportunities.



#### Marine

- <u>Waitt Foundation</u> Rapid Ocean Conservation
  - Not limited
  - <u>Deadline</u>: Proposals for grants up to \$20,000 will be reviewed on a <u>monthly</u> rolling basis.
  - Will fund projects related to the Waitt Foundation's mission of supporting sustainable fishing and marine protected areas. This includes sub-themes of: Scientific Research, Policy, Management, & Communications.

#### Medical Research

- Foundation for Prader-Willi Research FPWR Grant Program
  - Not limited
  - o <u>Deadline:</u> LOI due February 28, 2025 | September 5, 2025
  - May request up to \$150,000 in direct costs for an initial 18 months of support.
  - Aims to eliminate the challenges of Prader-Willi syndrome through the advancement of research and therapeutic development.

### The Elsa U. Pardee Foundation – Cancer Research

- Not limited
- o Deadline: December 15, April 30, August 31
- Funds ranges up to \$200,000.
- The foundation encourages one-year proposals, with the goal of fostering the capabilities of new cancer researchers or new cancer approaches by established cancer researchers.


#### Other

  - <u>Deadline:</u> rolling basis throughout the year
  - Applications may request \$20,000 or less
  - Local Florida Impact Grants work in these areas: Vibrant Economies, Climate Resiliency, Justice, Equity and Inclusion

#### Sociology

- Sociological Initiatives Foundation Community-Based Participatory Research Projects
  - Not limited
  - o Deadline: August 15, 2025
  - Grant amounts range from \$15k \$25k
