 - <u>Geographical Giving Scope</u>: National
 - *Deadline:* April 9, 2025
 - The foundation invites applications for its Hemangiosarcoma Initiative, which aims to catalyze the development of new approaches to prevent, detect, and treat canine hemangiosarcoma. There are two categories:
 - Seed Awards: Maximum of \$25k to support proof-of-concept studies, high-risk, high-reward projects, or where additional data is required for a larger proposal.
 - Innovation Awards: Maximum of \$200k, these proposals are supported by preliminary data.

 - Ranges from \$2,500 \$50,000
 - Interested in activities that build connections between basic/early biomedical scientific approaches and ecological, environmental, geological, geographic, and planetary-scale thinking, as well as with population-focused fields, including epidemiology and public health, demography, economics, and urban planning.

- MIT Solve 2025 Global Learning Challenge
 - Not limited
 - <u>Geographical Giving Scope</u>: National
 - *Deadline:* April 17, 2025
 - Awarding \$10k in unrestricted funding and access to additional financing through grants and investments.
 - Recipients also receive a nine-month support program including tailored capacity-building workshops, leadership coaching, and exposure and networking opportunities.
 - The key areas of interest for this challenge include:
 - Increasing access to quality learning materials, particularly for those in emergency, conflict-affected areas, or with limited internet access.
 - Improving engagement and learning outcomes for individuals with disabilities and learning differences, while benefiting all learners.
 - Equipping people with critical skills for the modern world, such as problem-solving and AI literacy, along with adequate training for educators.

 The Peanut Institute Foundation is a non-profit 501(C)(3) entity that funds nutrition research. We are requesting scientific proposals that enhance the understanding of how consuming peanuts, peanut butter, peanut oil, and other peanut products affects health in various populations. For the 2025-2026 cycle, there are two grants that applicants can choose from.

<u>Sigma Global Nursing Excellence</u> – End-of-Life Nursing Care Research Grant

- Grant Award \$10,000
- The purpose of this grant is to encourage qualified nurses to contribute to the advancement of nursing care through research. Proposals for pilot and/or developmental research may be submitted for the grant.

• American Association for Cancer Research – Ocular Melanoma Foundation Research

- Geographical Giving Scope: National & International
- *Deadline:* April 8, 2025
- Grant Award \$130,000
- The AACR-Ocular Melanoma Foundation Research Fellowship represents a joint effort to encourage and support a postdoctoral or clinical research fellow to conduct ocular/uveal melanoma research and to establish a successful career path in ophthalmology, ocular oncology, uveal melanoma biology, or a similar field. The research proposed for funding must be translational or clinical in nature and must have direct, primary applicability and relevance to ocular/uveal melanoma.
- <u>SATB2 Gene Foundation</u> Research Grant Program

- <u>Geographical Giving Scope</u>: National
- *Deadline:* April 10, 2025
- The foundation is awarding up to \$20k
- To drive research momentum, the SATB2 Gene Foundation Board is highly
 interested in research proposals that would create pilot data sufficient to support
 larger scale grant submissions to other funding sources. In addition, projects that
 provide a foundation to support future potential therapeutic interventions, such
 as enhancing the understanding of measuring SATB2-related effects, will be of
 greater interest to the review committee.
- <u>Pfizer</u> Advances in Migraine Management
 - Not limited
 - Geographical Giving Scope: National
 - *Deadline:* April 21, 2025
 - The foundation is awarding grants of up to \$200k over up to two years. The estimated budget for this RFP is \$1M
 - Projects should be focused on improving the care, management, and outcomes
 of adult patients with migraines.
- <u>The Elsa U. Pardee Foundation</u> **Supporting Innovative Cancer Research**
 - Not limited
 - Geographical Giving Scope: National
 - *Deadline:* April 30, 2025
 - This early-stage funding by the Foundation may lead to subsequent and expanded support using government agency funding.
 - The average grant size is estimated at \$100k
 - The foundation encourages one-year proposals that enable new cancer researchers to establish their capabilities or established cancer researchers to create new approaches.

Mental Health

American Psychological Foundation (APA) - Visionary Grants

- <u>Geographical Giving Scope</u>: National
- *Deadline:* April 3, 2025
- The foundation is awarding 10 grants of up to \$20k
- The APF Visionary Grants seek to seed innovation through supporting research, education and intervention projects and programs that use psychology to solve social problems in a number of priority areas.

Other

- Native American Agriculture Fund 2025 Process General or Youth
 - Not limited
 - Geographical Giving Scope: National
 - <u>Deadline</u>: May 1, 2025
 - Grants of up to \$250k.
 - Applicants are encouraged to combine focus areas into one project, such as combining business assistance with technical support or agricultural education with business assistance.

Science/Technology

- Whitehall Foundation Research Grants & Grants-in-Aid
 - Not limited
 - <u>Geographical Giving Scope</u>: National
 - <u>Deadline:</u> LOI due April 15, 2025
 - The foundation is interested in basic research in neurobiology, defined as invertebrate and vertebrate (excluding clinical) neurobiology, specifically investigations of neural mechanisms involved in sensory, motor, and other complex functions of the whole organism as these relate to behavior.
 - The foundation has two grant programs:
 - Research: Grants of up to \$100k per year for two to three years, for established scientist working at accredited Institutions.
 - Grants-in-Aid: One-year grants of up to \$30k to researchers at the assistant professor level and to senior scientists.

- <u>KRESS Foundation</u> **History of Art Grants**
 - o Not limited
 - o Deadline: LOI due March 1, 2025
 - Awards range between \$10,000 \$100,000
 - The History of Art Grants program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.

Criminal Justice

- <u>Arnold Ventures</u> **Innovation Days**
 - Not limited
 - Deadline: on a rolling basis
 - This grant aims to bring researchers and practitioners together about solutions to pressing criminal justice problems.
 - This grant will support expenses for hosting meetings, travel/lodging, event deliverable production and personnel time for event planning.

 - Must check one or more of their priorities:
 - Promoting diversity, equity and belonging
 - Increasing collaboration among future health professionals
 - Prepare future health professionals to navigate ethical dilemmas

 - o Ranges from \$2,500 \$50,000
 - o Interested in activities that build connections between basic/early biomedical scientific approaches and ecological, environmental, geological, geographic, and planetary-scale thinking, as well as with population-focused fields, including epidemiology and public health, demography, economics, and urban planning.

Fellowships

- <u>Virginia Center for the Creative Arts</u> Fully-Funded Fellowships
 - o Not limited
 - Geographical giving scope: National
 - Deadline: January 15, 2025 | May 15, 2025 | September 15, 2025
 - Applicants will be considered for a VCCA residency and as many fully-funded fellowships for which they are eligible; only one application with a single application fee is required per deadline.

Health

- <u>WAWA Foundation</u> **Financial Grants**
 - Not limited
 - o Deadline: January, April, July and October

 - o Not limited
 - o <u>Deadline</u>: Rolling
 - There is no specific amount range for allowable budget requests.
 - This funding is focused on studies about upstream causes of health inequities, such as the systems, structures, laws, policies, norms, and practices that determine the distribution of resources and opportunities.

Marine

- Waitt Foundation Rapid Ocean Conservation
 - Not limited
 - <u>Deadline</u>: Proposals for grants up to \$20,000 will be reviewed on a <u>monthly</u> rolling basis.
 - Will fund projects related to the Waitt Foundation's mission of supporting sustainable fishing and marine protected areas. This includes sub-themes of: Scientific Research, Policy, Management, & Communications.

Medical Research

- <u>Foundation for Prader-Willi Research</u> FPWR Grant Program
 - Not limited
 - o <u>Deadline:</u> LOI due February 28, 2025 | September 5, 2025
 - May request up to \$150,000 in direct costs for an initial 18 months of support.
 - Aims to eliminate the challenges of Prader-Willi syndrome through the advancement of research and therapeutic development.
- The Elsa U. Pardee Foundation Cancer Research
 - Not limited
 - o <u>Deadline</u>: December 15, April 30, August 31
 - Funds ranges up to \$200,000.
 - The foundation encourages one-year proposals, with the goal of fostering the capabilities of new cancer researchers or new cancer approaches by established cancer researchers.



Other

 - <u>Limited</u> 1 submission per organization per calendar year

- Impact Fund Advance Social Justice
 - Not limited
 - o <u>Deadline</u>: LOIs due April 1, 2025. July 8, 2025. October 7, 2025
 - Grant amounts range from \$10k \$50k
 - This foundation grants nonprofit organizations, solo practitioners, or small legal firms that are involved in economic, environmental, racial, and social justice cases that will benefit a community facing systemic oppression.

Sociology

- <u>Sociological Initiatives Foundation</u> Community-Based Participatory Research Projects
 - Not limited
 - o Deadline: August 15, 2025
 - Grant amounts range from \$15k \$25k
 - This proposal is for community-academic partnerships that combine research with concrete social action strategies, prioritizing projects that promote racial justice and equitable laws, policies, and practices.
