- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: LOI due May 1, 2025
- Amount: Grant sizes vary, the average is \$50,000 - \$250,000
- The foundation has specific topic priority areas within their grantmaking program:
  - Caregiving, Economic Security in Later Life, Housing, Social and Intergenerational Connectedness, and Organizational Capacity Building

### Arts

- Amount: Up to \$10,000
- The foundation will award artists based on the quality of the artists' work, the potential to expand aesthetic inquiry, and the ability to fulfill the foundation's priority to provide support to visual artists under-recognized by the field.

- Amount: \$100,000 to \$600,000 over 2-3 years.

## Fellowship

### [American Association for Cancer Research](#) – **Exelixis Renal Cell Carcinoma Research Fellowship**

- Geographical Giving Scope: National & International
- Deadline: April 23, 2025
- Amount: \$130,000 over 2 years
- This grant is meant to support the salary and benefits of the fellow while they work on a mentored renal cell carcinoma research project.

### [Simons Foundation](#) – **Shenoy Undergraduate Research Fellowship in Neuroscience**

- Not Limited
- Geographical Giving Scope: National & International
- Deadline: May 1, 2025
- Amount: Fellows will each up to \$7,500 over 30 weeks.
- The goal of this program is to spark and sustain interest in neuroscience among undergraduate students who have not had access to research training opportunities.

- Amount: A grand prize of \$648K will be awarded in each category.
- The challenge seeks innovative, low-cost data and technology solutions in LMICs to improve antibiotic stock control and reduce the sale and use of substandard and falsified oral antibiotics.

### [Florida Blue Foundation](#) – Mental Well-being

- Limited Florida Blue will allow one proposal per priority per institution.
- Geographical Giving Scope: National
- Deadline: May 5, 2025
- Amount: Between \$270,000 - \$400,000
- This grant offers 2 funding priorities:
  - **Priority 1:** Addressing community mental health challenges. Provide mental health services to children, teens, adults, and/or seniors struggling with stress, anxiety, depression, isolation, loneliness, and other mental health challenges, with a focus on addressing unmet needs and promoting overall well-being.
  - **Priority 2:** Increase the pipeline of mental health professionals. Support the development and expansion of the mental health workforce to meet the growing demand for services, with a focus on increasing the number of trained professionals and improving access to care.

### [Florida Blue Foundation](#) – Food Security

- Limited Florida Blue will allow one proposal per priority per institution.
- Geographical Giving Scope: Florida
- Deadline: May 20, 2025
- Amount: Between \$270,000 - \$400,000



- This grant offers 2 funding priorities:
  - **Priority 1: Improving Chronic Health Conditions:** Addressing food insecurity and lack of access to affordable, nutritious food is crucial in reducing the risk of chronic health conditions such as heart disease, diabetes, and obesity, which are prevalent in Florida.
  - **Priority 2: Bridging the Rural Food Gap** Improving access to healthy food in rural communities is essential to addressing unique challenges faced by these areas where geographic isolation and limited resources often hinder access to fresh, nutritious options.

- Amount: Up to \$10,000
- The project should be conducted by a cross-country (at least two countries) nurse-led research team and focus on responding to health disparities globally. The PI should be a Registered Nurse.

### [Prostate Cancer Foundation](#) – **2025 Challenge Awards**

- Amount: Up to \$1M over two years
- Grants will be awarded to teams of at least three investigators from nonprofit academic research centers—including one young investigator—and will support large-scale research projects concerning metastatic, lethal prostate cancer.

  - The History of Art Grants program supports scholarly projects that will enhance the appreciation and understanding of European works of art and architecture from antiquity to the early 19th century.

### Criminal Justice

  - Deadline: on a rolling basis
  - This grant aims to bring researchers and practitioners together about solutions to pressing criminal justice problems.

  - Must check one or more of their priorities:
    - Promoting diversity, equity and belonging
    - Increasing collaboration among future health professionals

  - Not limited

  - Ranges from \$2,500 - \$50,000
  - Interested in activities that build connections between basic/early biomedical scientific approaches and ecological, environmental, geological, geographic, and planetary-scale thinking, as well as with population-focused fields, including epidemiology and public health, demography, economics, and urban planning.

#### Fellowships
